
The West Seneca Community of Churches is requesting the permission of the Town Board to hold our annual Crop Walk to stop world hunger in our town on October 27, 2013 from approximately 1:00pm-4:00pm. The walk begins at 2:00pm.

For the past twenty five years West Seneca has participated with Church World Service to hold a Crop Walk to raise money to help stop world hunger. Last year we earned \$3,366.81. Twenty five percent of all money raised is given to the West Seneca Food Pantry to help the needy in our own community. To date over the years, I am proud to announce West Seneca has raised a grand total of \$151,991.86 !

Upon the anticipated approval from the Town, we would like to begin our walk at Ebenezer United Church of Christ at 2:00 pm and use the Church as a gathering point, and then we proceed down Union Road to Reserve Rd. and return back to the Ebenezer UCC.
