For over the past twenty five years the town of West Seneca has participated with Church World Service to hold a Crop Walk to raise money to help stop world and local hunger. Last year we earned approximately \$2,000.00. Twenty five percent of all money raised is given to the West Seneca Food Pantry to help the needy in our own community. To date over the years, I am proud to announce West Seneca has raised a grand total of \$154,000.00 !


