

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW NO. 11 FOR THE YEAR 2015

REVISION TO CHAPTER 103, SECTION 22.1 OF THE TOWN OF WEST SENECA CODE

ENTITLED "STREETLIGHTING"

§ 103-22.1. Streetlighting.

- A. The developer must request a streetlighting proposal from the New York State Electric and Gas Corporation.
- B. The plan must provide for LED lights to be installed and must be approved by the Planning Board prior to installation.
- C. The developer must have underground wiring and the installation of underground fed fixtures installed by the contractor of his choice. All posts and fixtures must conform to the New York State Electric and Gas Corporation's specifications, or the developer may arrange for the New York State Electric and Gas Corporation to make the installation. Upon acceptance of the highway or street, the Town of West Seneca will then own the underground wiring and standards.
