355 Harlem Road

Kindly move to adopt the attached resolution requesting the New York State Department of Transportation to re-evaluate the placement of a traffic signal at 355 Harlem Road.

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE NYS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION  
TO RE-EVALUATE THE PLACEMENT OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT 355 HARLEM ROAD**

**Whereas,** the traffic on Harlem Road(Route 240) intersecting with Erie 1 BOCES (355 Harlem Road) and Multisorb Technologies (325 Harlem Road) is a serious concern to the Town of West Seneca; and

**Whereas,** previous requests to the NYS Department of Transportation to support the placement of a traffic signal at these locations have been denied; and

**Whereas,** Erie 1 BOCES employs 400 people and have 100-300 additional people during conferences; Erie 1 BOCES have also expressed an interest in expanding their current facility with the potential of adding 100-300 more employees and Multisorb Technologies employs 350 people; and

**Whereas,** the Erie County SPCA will be building a new 42,000 square foot facility on the 10 acre parcel across from Multisorb Technologies and Erie 1 BOCES which will further increase the volume of traffic in that area; and

**Resolved,** that the Town of West Seneca is requesting the placement of a trigger light in this area and request that the New York State Department of Transportation conduct a traffic signal warrant analysis, and BE IT FURTHER

**Resolved,** that the Town Clerk is directed to send certified copies of this resolution to New York State Senator Timothy Kennedy, New York State Senator Patrick Gallivan, New York State Assemblymember Michael Kearns and Erie County Legislator Joseph Lorigo.
