# TOWN OF WEST SENECA TOWN BOARD SEQRA DETERMINATION FOR PHASE 5 SEWER IMPROVEMENTS STUDY

WHEREAS, the Town of West Seneca Town Board (the "Board") has considered the impact to the environment of following Scope of Work to be completed:

- **PHASE 5 SEWER IMPROVEMENTS STUDY**
  - Study and recommendations for improvements to sewer subsystems in the Town of West Seneca
  - Work includes, but not limited to, Town Sewer Crews taking video of the phase 5 area, Engineer reviewing the video and making recommendations for sewer improvements, review of manhole conditions and recommendations for improvements and smoke testing of specific areas in phase 5 to further investigate problem areas discovered through video investigation

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the Scope of Work set forth above as one Proposed Action, and has further consulted with its Engineer and legal counsel with respect to the potential for environmental impacts resulting from the Proposed Action,

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the Proposed Action with respect to the Type II criteria set forth in 6 NYCRR. Part 617 of the Environmental Conservation Law, Article 8 ("SEQRA") and concluded that the project involves:

- Study of sewer improvements that would result in replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of infrastructure or facility, in kind, on the same site,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board as follows:

- The Proposed Action, individually and cumulatively, does not constitute substantial changes to the existing facilities or infrastructure and involves routine activities required for proper operation and maintenance of the Town Highway Garage, and, therefore, does not exceed the thresholds for a Type II Action established under 6 N.Y.C.R.R. Part 617.
- The Board hereby determines the Proposed Action is a Type II action in accordance with SEQRA regulations.
- No further review of the Proposed Action is required under SEQRA.
- This resolution shall be effective immediately.
