 - a. Bikes
 - There is a need for a transportation plan for the town as was proposed in the Town's comprehensive plan from 2016. This would include planning for bike lanes on roadways. Action:
 - b. Trees
 - NYSDEC Grant for Tree Inventory and Urban Forestry Management Plan (UFMP)
 Action: Town still has to provide some forms to NYSDEC, and the contract with NYSDEC is not executed yet. Action:
 - 2. Recommendations for the revised tree list and update of town codes to reference it. Town Board deferred to the town attorney for review in March 2023. Action:
 - 3. Questions have arisen regarding the expertise the town has for maintaining newly planted trees in town parks for the long term. Problems were noted with newer trees in the BNAC grounds lacking proper maintenance, reducing their chances for survival. Action:
 - c. Education
 - 1. Set up a commission display at BNAC building Action: Evelyn Hicks, Barb Lipiew
 - d. Waterways
 - 1. The commission has 60 storm drain medallions (markers) that can be installed on curb locations for storm drains. The past efforts to install these are commendable. However, these medallions become detached and damaged after a few years and require replacement, which adds on-going costs. Requested feedback from the town attorney about any liability concerns with potential injury to those installing and the public, due to the adhesive material properties and installation method. Action:
 - 2. Any updates on past grants for waterways? Evelyn Hicks
 - e. Community Needs and Interests, etc.
 - Congratulations to Ryan Taylor for being appointed as the Municipal Representative for the Town on the Erie County Environmental Management Council!

6) Governance

- a) Suggestion to add a Co-Vice Chair for the commission, which is allowed per the commission's By-Laws.
- b) As of January 1, 2025 there will be a new vacancy for one commission member, and there is still a vacancy for a youth member to be filled.
- c) Nomination of Danielle Bagley as an associate commission member. Note: After nomination, the formal vote to approve associate members normally occurs at the next commission meeting.

- a) NYS DEC Smoke Creek Habitat Opportunity Assessment Report Evelyn Hicks
- b) As an advisory commission, we need to be aware of changes at the federal government level beginning on January 20, 2025. There are significant changes being proposed for the Environmental Protection Agency, the Department of Energy, and the Department of the Interior, and many others. The elimination of Climate Change as a concern for federal government action, legislation, regulations, and programs is also planned. Locally for our town, the short-term and long-term impacts of these changes are currently unknown. Action:
- c) About 1 year ago, the power company took down 90% of the trees (mature) on Covington because they might someday reach the power lines. The agreement with the Town was that the power company could take them down and the Town would plant new ones for each house, homeowner's choice. The new trees have not been planted. Action:
