This letter is a follow-up to an e-mail that was sent on Friday
February 18,2022. This issue refers to the sewage back-up on Sunbriar
Drive.

After a strong recent weather event, numerous houses on our street
experienced MAJOR sewage backup in their homes. There are 32
homes on our street. Upon visiting the owners of all, but 2 homes (they
were not home after multiple tries) only 5 DID NOT experience any
back-up issues. That means 25 houses had sewage issues. Also 1 house
on West Willowdale experienced sewage issues. Enclosed are the
names and addresses of all residents that experienced sewer backups.
(1 resident on Sunbriar had sewage issues, but for personal reasons, did
not want to sign the enclosed sheet). Some residents had MAJOR
damage, while others, were lucky enough to escape with minor issues.

After the recent sanitary sewer slip lining, this issue should not have
occurred at all. Of course, various neighbors had called the town to
voice their complaints, after the damage was done and were given
various explanations. Among them:

- The pumps on West Willowdale were turned on too late.
- The recently installed catch basin on West Willowdale was
installed TOO HIGH, thus was not functioning correctly.

- With the amount of snow on the ground, the thaw, and the rain that occurred, the system was over-taxed.
- We all have cracks in our lateral lines adding to the overabundance of water in the sewage line.

We understand the amount of precipitation was excessive, however, why was OUR STREET taking the brunt of sewage. The sanitary manhole covers were overflowing. I have a few friends on Emerald and they had NO ISSUES. Tomorrow, February 22, the weather is calling for a half-inch of rain. Are we suppose to be on sewage outlook every time we have any inclement weather?


I have lived here for 24 years, and we have never had an event of this magnitude, even with ice jams. Upon talking with the residents on Sunbriar, all this sewage back up became more evident AFTER the slip-lining was installed. In her, more than 20-year residency, the homeowner on West Willowdale NEVER had a sewage back-up event until last week.

We understand things changed with the slip-lining, but this should have NEVER occurred. It was our understanding that the slip-lining would have made our sewers better, not worse.

We, as tax paying residents, request an explanation as to why this event happened and what solutions the town will take, so that this does not occur in the future.

We would be happy to meet with anyone that could answer our questions and concerns.
