<i>Amelanchier laevis</i>	Allegheny Serviceberry
<i>Comus florida</i>	Flowering Dogwood
<i>Carpinus caroliniana</i>	American Hornbeam
<i>Amelanchier arborea</i>	Common Serviceberry
<i>Crataegus spp.</i>	Hawthorn

Native, Large Trees (>30')

Scientific Name	Common Name
<i>Celtis occidentalis</i>	Northern Hackberry
<i>Acer rubrum</i>	Red Maple...and several other maples
<i>Ostrya virginiana</i>	American Hop-Hornbeam
<i>Quercus spp.</i>	Swamp White, Scarlet, Bur, Black, White, Chestnut (Oaks)
<i>Tilia americana</i>	American Basswood
<i>Nyssa sylvatica</i>	Blackgum
<i>Liriodendron tulipifera</i>	Tulip Tree
