Marriage License, Local Fee Waiver for Active Duty Military Members

On August 20, 2019, New York State Governor Andrew Cuomo signed into law Senate (S.3756) and Assembly (A.55) bills which waves the state fee for marriage licenses when either applicant for such marriage license is on active duty as a member of the United States Armed Forces and further authorizes Towns and Cities to elect to waive local fees.

Pursuant to this law, kindly authorize Jacqueline Felser, Town Clerk, to waive the local fee for marriage licenses and certificates in the Town of West Seneca when either applicant is on active duty as member of the United States Armed Forces.
