I am proud to have designated a total of \$315,000 in State and Municipal funds for various projects in the Town of West Seneca, each of which have been specifically requested and outlined by the Town and reviewed by my office.

\$100,000 of this allocation is to go toward the restoration and re-opening of the Burchfield Nature and Art Center on Union Road. Councilman Bill Bauer has provided plans that include timelines, costs, and a detailed outline of the work that will be completed with this grant.
