Good evening,

As part of our on-going initiative to improve our Community's baseball facilities, the West Seneca Youth Baseball Association would like to move forward with constructing Home Run fences at the following baseball diamonds. Please see the attached plan for additional information:

1. **Harlem Rd. Park and Dirkson Park** (*Center Field fence to be approximately 200' from Home Plate and Right/Left Field fence to be approximately 175' from Home Plate*)
 - a. Harlem 1
 - b. Harlem 2
 - c. Harlem 3
 - d. Dirkson

2. **Fireman's Park** (*Center Field fence to be approximately 253' from Home Plate and Right/Left Field fence to be approximately 230' from Home Plate*)
 - a. Fireman's 1
 - b. Fireman's 2

All fencing will be capped with the protective plastic top, similar to what was installed on the Home Run Fence at Fireman's 3. I have included a photo as the last page of the attached document for your reference.

When we spoke about this a year ago, you mentioned that you need to present this at one of the Town's Board Meetings. By way of this email, I am requesting that you put this on the Agenda for the next meeting. We are anxious to get this work installed before the season starts. Therefore, time is of the essence. Please let me know if you would like me to attend the Board Meeting so I can answer any & all questions at that time.

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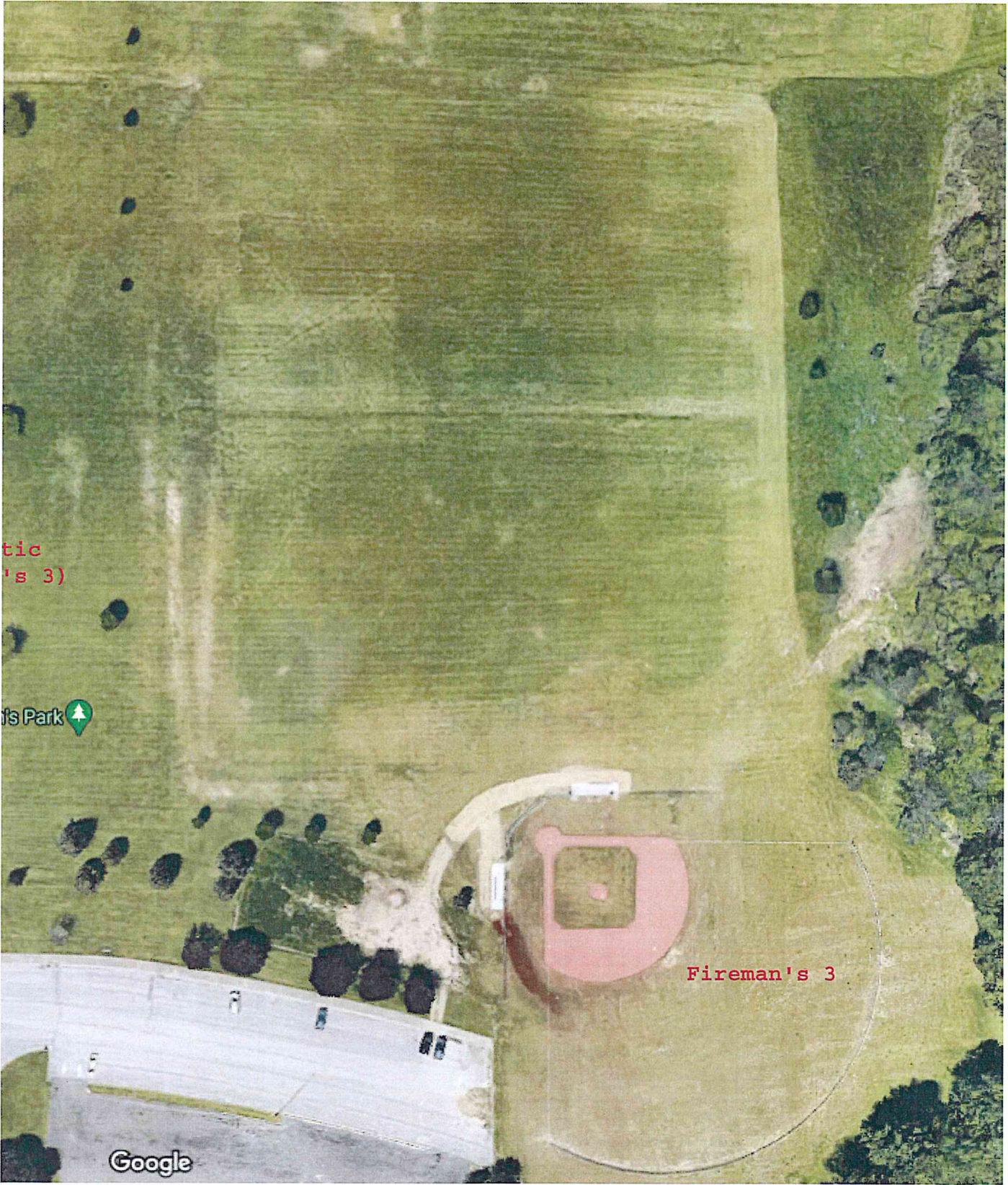
