

Resolution for CARES Act Re-allocation

WHEREAS, on January 14, 2021, New York State Department of Labor Commissioner Roberta Reardon signed an Order that temporarily cancels unemployment insurance charges to employers for the duration of the COVID-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, this made unemployment costs unallowable for reimbursement under the CARES Act guidelines;

WHEREAS, the Town of West Seneca was reimbursed for unemployment insurance costs in the amount of \$89,337.24 as part of their CARES Act reimbursement prior to this change;

WHEREAS, on May 6, 2021, Erie County Division of Budget and Management notified the Town of West Seneca the opportunity to re-allocate the amount of reimbursed unemployment insurance expenses to other COVID-19 expenses;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOVLED, that the Town Board does hereby authorize the attached 2021 budget transfer to account for the re-allocation of COVID-19 expenditures covered by the Federal CARES Act.
